Pastoral Note...

Truth Must Have a Relationship Context

One of the values of a blog is that a pastor can include information that time didn't allow in a series like our current topic. As I was in Paul's letter to Timothy yesterday, I wanted to say so many things about truth. One of those things is that the truth requires a relationship.

In 2 Timothy 3:14-16, he told Timothy to remember from whom he learned the truth (verse 14). He didn't say "remember what you learned," or "remember how you learned it," or even "remember why you learned." It was WHO did the teaching that was important to Paul. And who was it?

WHO teaches the members of my family the truth is a very important matter. Some of us think that if Paul had been our teacher, the one who taught us would be important too. But hold on; Paul wasn't talking about himself teaching Timothy. In 2 Timothy 1:5, Paul says that Timothy's faith was first in his grandmother Lois and in his mother Eunice. It is vital for us to understand that truth is most powerfully taught in the context of relationship.

We need a relationship with the learner AND with the author. At the end of the day, it's all about Jesus Christ. Many people have a relationship of some sort with the Bible, but not the Person that the Bible tells us of. All true worship flows from knowing the Christ of Scripture.

What I'm reading: *You Are Not A Gadget*, by Jaron Lanier. This book is meant to persuade us that we are being reduced to the least common denominator through social media, networking, computer programs, and a host of other everyday items. I admire the broad view of the author, and I share the concern, but I'm not sure I follow his conclusions about a solution.

Haiti Response:

We have received our first request from NAMB for DR volunteers to go to Haiti. Two of our men will be flying out this Saturday morning to do water purification for other Southern Baptist DR volunteers on-site. Please be in prayer for them as they travel to and from Haiti. Pray that they will be safe while serving there. Please pray that they will be able to share their faith with the people of Haiti.

Buckets of Hope:

Deadline for the buckets is March 8, so that we have a week to gather them from around the state by March 15. Collection sites for the Buckets of Hope are being secured now. Disaster Relief Training:

We have had tremendous response to the upcoming Disaster Relief Phase 1 training offered at Hebron Baptist Church in Dacula. Approximately 750 people are signed up. Please pray that it will be a quality, Christ-centered event. Please pray that those who attend will understand the ministry of Disaster Relief and know if they are called to it or not.
