for the paper towels, hand sanitizer wipes

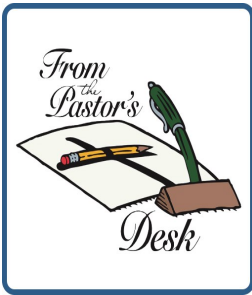
for the 10 lbs. of miniature candy treats
