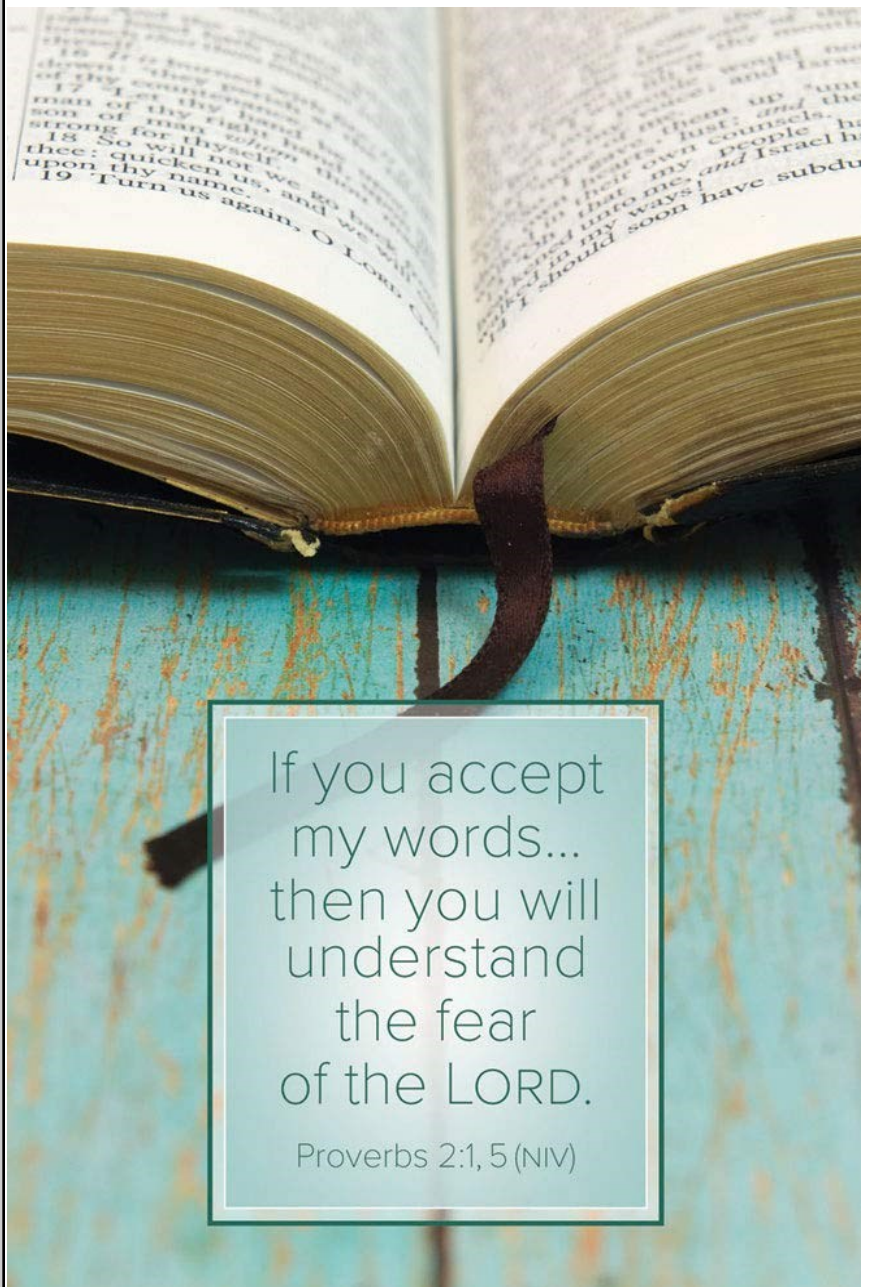

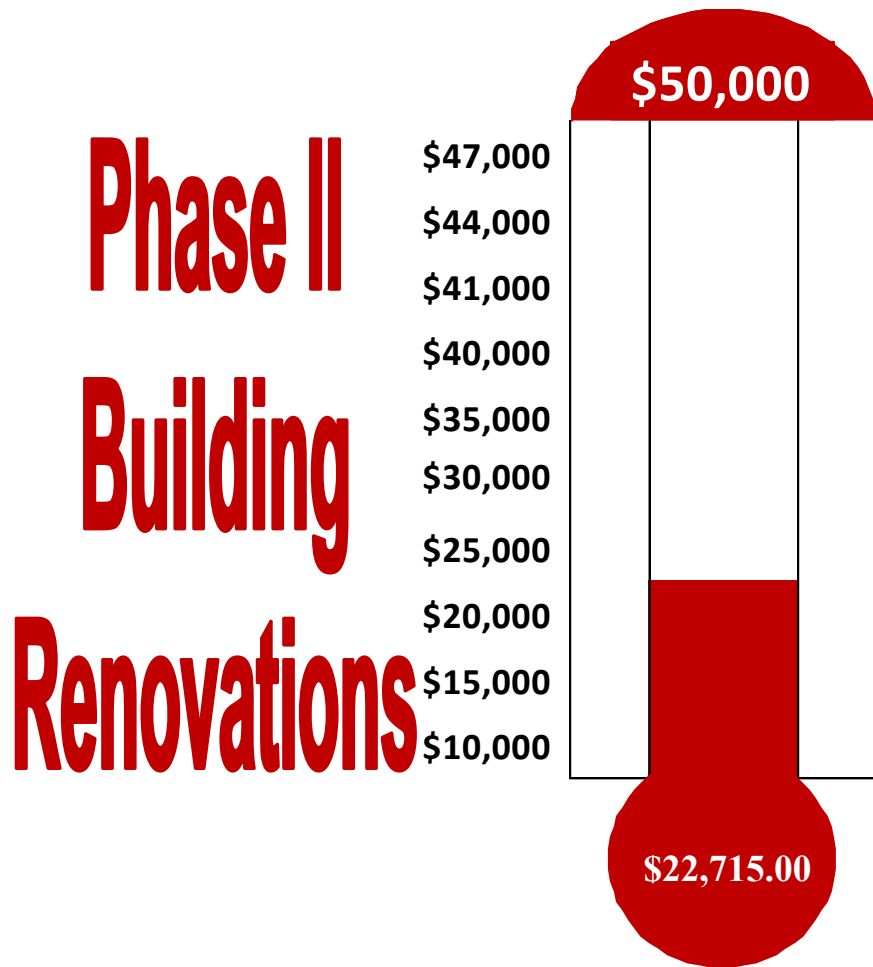

For our children's Bible Studies, we've been using Bible Studies for Life Curriculum. Did you know that in their curriculum, they pack in 10 different concepts to teach the children: God, Jesus, Holy Spirit, Bible, Salvation, Creation, Church, People, Family, Community & World. What great concepts to teach our children and have them build their foundation of knowledge upon these things. The concepts help to establish a foundational truth for babies, and as they grow it gets added to toddlers, preschoolers, early grades and older grades. Sometimes I think it is a challenge to think about my own spiritual development. Where am I? Where are you? ... Can we look at that list of ten concepts and answer questions about what does the Bible say about those things? Who is God? Who is Jesus? What does the Bible say about Creation? What does the Bible say about families? ... I'm thankful for the curriculum to help us teach the children and establish a good foundation for when they are older.



## **IMPROVEMENTS NEEDED TO BUILDING AND GROUNDS PHASE II**

The Operations Team would like to thank everyone who gave of their time, donations of equipment, and money to make much needed improvements in Phase I of our efforts to renovate our building and grounds. Now we need to transition into Phase II to make repairs and improvements to the Sanctuary and other areas in Building 100. We need to raise approximately \$50,000 to paint the Sanctuary, hallways, door frames, and also the cabinets in the restrooms. We need new carpet in the Sanctuary, hallways, and classrooms on the south wing. We are still using the original carpet placed in the church when it was built.

We realize this is a BIG undertaking, but we are going to trust God to provide the funds. He has already provided us with a family who is challenging us by offering to match the first \$10,000 raised by the church family. So when we raise the first \$10,000 we immediately have \$20,000 so we will be well on our way to meeting our goal of \$50,000. We will not start any of the work until we collect the full \$50,000 as we do not want to continually disrupt the activities in Building 100 nor do we want to start something we cannot finish. We are asking each family to pray about what you can give, but only above your regular tithes and offerings. Read 2 Chronicles 24 about the Chest of Joash, and if you have children, explain to them how King Joash used a chest to help raise money to repair God's temple. We are going to place our Chest of Joash at the front of the Sanctuary for you to place your gifts in it, and it will be a great learning experience for our children to drop their pennies and nickels in to help repair God's house by all working together.

Thank you, Summit Family, for going beyond meeting the needs of Phase I, and let's trust the Lord as we move forward with Phase II. We love you, and know God will bless you richly for all you are doing.
