Adult tickets are \$10 and children tickets are \$5. Tickets will include a choice of pasta plate, dessert, drink, and entertainment!

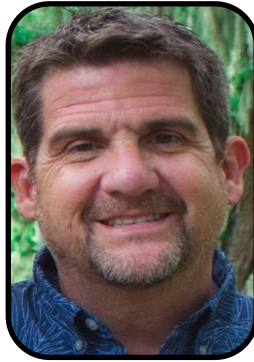

Preschool and Children's Ministry

PARENTS

These days and times are sometimes trying. It seems that everywhere we turn we are having to think about security. There is no place that is more concerned about your children and their safety than here at church. There are policies in place to make sure that while your children are here they are not only taught and cared for but protected as well. In light of this, let's review for just a minute the steps that you as parents can take to help us so that everyone is safe.

When dropping off your preschooler either in Sunday School or during the worship hour, please fill out a security tag. Keep the numbered half for you and place the other half on your child's back. Teachers will be instructed to check tags before releasing the children. Please remember that only adults can drop off and pick up children and you must have a tag.

Parents, as much as you possibly can, please stay outside the door of the classroom when dropping off or picking up. This allows for better security of children staying in the classroom during transitions. If there are medical issues or allergy issues with your children, please let the person at the preschool/children's hub know what those issues are. Also, communicate with your child's teachers.

We have now implemented the same security check in and pick up system on Wednesday nights. This system will be for preschoolers and grade school children. You will receive a tag as you drop your child off each Wednesday evening. You will need your tag to pick them up at the end of the class time.

As we work with our SERT team we will be reviewing and working on tightening up any security issues that we need to in order to make this the safest place possible for your children. Thank you for working with us.
