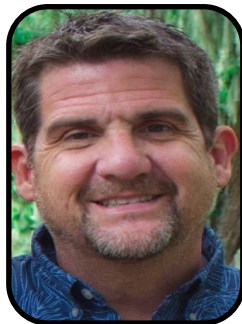

How many times have you heard someone ask, “Who cares?” I’ve heard it, and even said it myself, perhaps a thousand times. When I really stop and think about “Who cares?” my immediate response is – God cares! He really does. In fact, the Bible is full of example after example of the caring heart of God. In all honesty, the entire message of the Bible is that God cares about man so much He sent His Son to save us.

The real question is not, “Does God care?” The important question is, “Do WE care?” If we truly desire to live like Jesus lived, then we must learn to care like He cared. Jesus has actually left us here to care for others in His place. As someone once said, “we are like Jesus with skin on!” Until Christ returns, the earthly task of caring is in our hands.

I have been a Christ follower long enough to realize that being an agent of care doesn’t come naturally for every person. Some people are more caring than others, but everyone can grow as a caregiver. In fact, I think what Christ is looking for in His followers is a level of care that is not even natural. He is looking for a level of care that is supernatural!

Can you imagine what might happen if an individual or a group started caring for each other in a supernatural way? People would feel a sense of support and encouragement like they had never felt before. That would be very cool!

A movement of caring begins with one. That’s all it takes. If just one person decides to start caring the way Jesus cared, look out – revival may be on the way. Could that movement of caring begin with you? Are you willing to let God do the supernatural in and through you?
